Gentlemen:

Shell Oil Company requests cancellation of the Blinebry Gas Allowable assigned to our Sarkeys No. 2, Unit K, Section 23, T-21-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The date of cancellation should be February 19, 1964, which is the completion date for Shell Sarkeys 4 in the Blinebry Oil Pool.

We intend to convert all of the 160-acre Sarkeys Lease to Blinebry Oil production by March 1, 1964. Cancellation of the gas allowable will permit assignment of Blinebry oil allowables to each well on the date of the potential tests.
