DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Dumped 10 sacks cement with dump bailer from 3835 to 3817'. Ripped 7" casing and pulled 3645'. Filled hole with mud to 3414', ripped and pulled 8 1/2" from 2156'. Set 20 sack cement plug at 2156' and filled hole with mud to 1460'. Set 20 sack cement plug from 1440 to 1460'. Pulled 10" casing and filled hole with mud to 760'. Pulled 759' of 12 1/2", pulled 471' of 15 1/2" and filled hole with mud to 210'. Pulled 206' of 20" casing, filled hole with mud and rock to bottom of cellar and cemented in 4" pipe marker.
