NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ABANDON WELL

Notice must be given at least five days before work is to begin to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the plugging of wells being abandoned whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that it is our intention to abandon **State "B"** Well
No. **1** in _____ of Sec. **8** of Sec. **8**, T. **21**, R. **35**,
N. M. P. M., **Lea** Oil Field, **Lea** County.
We plan to commence work on **June 10, 1934**, 19____.

The reasons for wishing to abandon the well are as follows: **Well will only produce about two barrels oil with about 600 barrels water daily which will not justify operating expenses.**

The present condition of the well is as follows: **T.D. of well is 3836 feet**

The work which we propose to do in abandoning the well is as follows:
Cement producing formation, pull all casing and fill hole with mud.
