By Order of the Commission on the 3rd. day of October, 1963, The Western Oil Fields, Inc., was after hearing given approval to drill and complete as a quadruple completion the Gulf Hill No. 4 Well, located in Unit S, Section 4, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

In the process of completing the well it was found that:

- 1. The Tubb Gas or Oil Zone was not productive.
- 2. The Glorietta was not productive.
- 3. The Penrose-Skelly was not productive.
