9/28 Drilling at 11,361'. D.S.T. #13, 11210'-11,350', 1/2" B.H.C., 1 hour test. GTS in 12 min. Tested 2 hours on 1/2" surface choke, 70° w. p., 473 SURF; 1 hour on 2 1/2" surface choke, 203° w. p., 161 SURF; 1 hour on 16/64" surface choke, 343° w. p., 150 SURF. Recovered 850' of heavily gas and distillate cut mud. IBIP 2829' in 33 mins., 171 SURF, 772 SURF, 751 SURF 6720' in 1 hour, INP 7495, VNP 7374. Temp 154° F.
