1. Pressure test casing to 2,000 psig. Test deadman anchors.
2. MRU workover unit. ND wellhead. NU BOP. RIse On-Off tool. POOH w/ 2-7/8" tbg.
3. RIH w/ tbg & On-Off tool hydrotesting tbg to 9,000 psig.
4. Circulate pkr fluid. Engage On-Off tool. ND BOP. NU wellhead. Test wellhead to 5,000 psig & csg to 2,000 psig.
5. Install wellhead isolation tool. NU treating & flowback equip. RU fracture stimulation equipment & CO2 pumping equipment. RU pop-off valve on csg & trap w/ 2,000 psig pressure.
6. Fracture stimulate Morrow formation perforations from 13,908' - 14' & 13,940' - 60' with 11,000 gallons frac fluid, 75 tons CO2, & 32,000 lbs. proppant
7. RD frac equipment. Flow back well to pit or tank to clean up.
8. RU flow back equipment. Tie well in to sales line. Place well on production.
9. Rig down workover unit & clean location. Move off location.

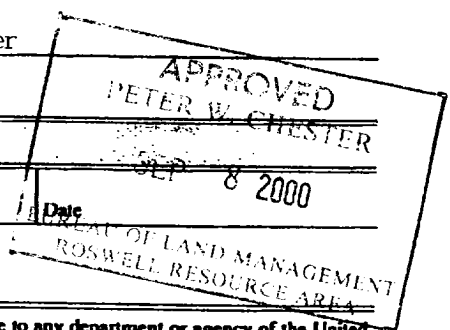
