Dear Mr. LeMay:

Chevron U.S.A. is planning to recomplete the **W. A. Ramsey (NCT-A) # 51** in the Eumont YTS-7RVRS (Pro Gas) Pool. The well currently is completed in the Eumont (QN/PNRS) Oil Pool. The location of the proposed recompletion is 1980' FNL and 510' FEL in Section 35, T-21-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

The captioned well is on an existing standard 640-acre Eumont gas spacing and proration unit (GPU) which comprises all of Section 35, T-21-S, R-36-E according to Administrative Order NSL-990(SD), dated November 8, 1978. The same order authorized the addition of the **W. A. Ramsey (NCT-A) # 13**, located at an unorthodox gas well location of 660' from the North and 1980' from the East line of Section 35, T-21-S, R-36-E, to the subject standard GPU. This order was amended several times to include the simultaneous dedication of **W. A. Ramsey (NCT-A) Nos. 3, 10, 12, and 13**. We respectfully request that the production from the **W. A. Ramsey (NCT-A) # 51** be simultaneously dedicated to the subject GPU with the existing wells.

Because the location of the subject well is 510' from the east boundary of the 640-acre GPU, we also request your approval for an unorthodox well location.
