* Request approval to change from LACT to gauged tank pipeline sales. Texas-New Mexico Pipeline (Transporter) and Exxon Corp. (Operator) have agreed to discontinue the LACT unit installed at the Wantz Federal Tank Battery effective 10-1-91. Sales have reduced such that maintenance of the LACT unit is not economical.

Lease sales will continued through the pipeline with the storage tanks gauged prior to and then again after the sales. Total gross sales will be calculated by subtracting the closing tank gauge from the opening tank gauge with the gross oil barrels being adjusted by the oil fluid properties; such as the BS&W, tank, and run temperatures.
