On July 16, 1993, Chevron U.S.A. submitted an administrative application for the subject non-standard well location in the Eumont YTS-7RVRS-QN (Pro Gas) Pool. The subject well is planned as a newly drilled completion in the Eumont pool.

On August 12, 1993, we received NMOCD notification that an objection to the application from Conoco, Inc. has been submitted, and that the application would be placed on the docket for the September 9, 1993 Examiner Hearing. We do not wish to defend this well location at the aforementioned hearing, and have moved the proposed well location to a standard 990' FNL and 1880' FWL of Section 14, T-21-S, R-36-E.

We respectfully request that the subject administrative application be withdrawn. We will submit amended C-102 plats and drilling permits upon the surveying of the new well location.
