The following is required information concerning the possible effect which the drilling of this well may have on the environment, existing road sites, and surrounding acreage. A copy will be posted on the derrick floor so all contractors and sub-contractors will be aware of all items of this plan.

1. Existing Roads

- A. The proposed well site is 990' FSL & 660' FWL, Sec. 17, T-21S, R-36E, Lea County, New Mexico.
- B. Exhibit "A" is a portion of a New Mexico road map and Exhibit "B.1" is a lease road map showing existing roads and wells. Directions to the location are as follows:

From the junction of State highways #8 and #176 (west of Eunice) go west 1.5 miles on highway #176. Turn right .15 miles, then turn left .2 mile to location.

C. No improvement or maintenance is anticipated for the existing roads.

2. Planned Access Roads

- A. A new 230' X 15' access road will be required as shown by the Exhibit "C.1" survey plat.
- B. No turnout will be required.
- C. No culverts, or fills will be required.
- D. No gates, cattleguards, or fences will be required.
- 3. Location of Existing Wells

See Exhibit "B.2" for a plat showing well locations.

4. Location of Proposed Facilities if Well is Productive

Since this is a proposed gas well, no production facilities are anticipated. A 7.5' quadrangle topo map of the area is included as Exhibit "B.1".

5. <u>Water Supply</u>

Brine and fresh water will be trucked in from the city of Eunice by the same route described for reaching the drilling location.
