OXY is planning to drill and complete the Felton A #4 in the Eumont Yates 7 RVRS Qn (Pro Gas) Pool. In order to produce this well, it is necessary to simultaneously dedicate the existing 160-acre Eumont Gas Proration Unit currently assigned to our Felton A #1. This well had been staked at a legal location, but had to be moved to avoid a pipeline, which resulted in an unorthodox location.
