

**SURFACE USE PLAN  
Conoco Inc.**

**Lockhart A-18 #9**

The following is required information concerning the possible affect which the drilling of this well may have on the environment, existing road sites, and surrounding acreage. A copy will be posted on the derrick floor so all contractors and sub-contractors will be aware of all items of this plan.

1. Existing Roads

A. The proposed well site is 660' FSL & 760' FWL, Sec. 18, T21S, R36E, Lea County, New Mexico.

B. Directions to the location are as follows:

From Eunice NM intersection of Hwy 207 and 8 and 176 turn north on Hwy 8 & 176 for 6.4 miles; turn west on Hwy 176 and travel 2.6 miles; turn north and travel 1/10 of a mile; turn west and travel 2/10 mile to location.

C. No improvement or maintenance is anticipated for the existing roads.

2. Planned Access Roads

A. No new access road will be required.

B. No turnouts will be needed.

C. No culverts will be needed.

D. No gates, cattleguards, or fences will be needed.

3. Topographic Map and Well Location

A 7.5" quadrangle topo map was filed with the NOS.

4. Additional Rights-of-Way

Electric line and flowline as shown on attached plats.

5. Water Supply

Fresh and brine water will be obtained from Goldstar's Water Station located 3 miles north of Eunice on Hwy. 207, and will be trucked to location by the same directions for reaching the drilling site.

6. Source of Construction Materials

Construction materials will be obtained from the SW/4 SW/4, Sec. 17, T21S, R36E, Lea County, NM.
