### 1. Existing Roads

- A. The proposed well site is 660' FSL & 760' FWL, Sec. 18, T21S, R36E, Lea County, New Mexico.
- B. Directions to the location are as follows:

From Eunice NM intersection of Hwy 207 and 8 and 176 turn north on Hwy 8 & 176 for 6.4 miles; turn west on Hwy 176 and travel 2.6 miles; turn north and travel 1/10 of a mile; turn west and travel 2/10 mile to location.

C. No improvement or maintenance is anticipated for the existing roads.

# 2. Planned Access Roads

- A. No new access road will be required.
- B. No turnouts will be needed.
- C. No culvedrts will be needed.
- D. No gates, cattleguards, or fences will be needed.

#### 3. <u>Topographic Map and Well Location</u>
