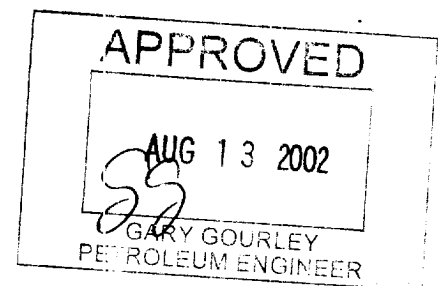

Propose to use the Lea County alternate casing program as in the permit.
Drill a 12 1/4" hole to 400 feet and set 8 5/8", 24#/ft, J55 casing. Cement to surface with 350 sx Class C with 2% calcium chloride, 14.8 ppg, 1.34 cf/sack, 24 hr comp strength = 1800 psi, 72 hr comp strength = 3000 psi
