A cement retainer was set at 3560' and squeezed section below with 100 sacks of cement. Hole was filled with heavy mud. Parted and pulled 8-5/8" casing from 1600' and spotted a cement plug of 30 sacks from 1660' to 1540'. (In top of parted 8-5/8" casing and bottom of 10" casing). The 10" casing was parted and pulled from 1000'. Spotted a cement plug of 30 sacks from approximately 1040' to 930' (in top of parted 10" casing in bottom of 12-1/2" casing). All attempts to part and pull 12-1/2" casing were unsuccessful, and all 18-5/8" casing was left in the hole. The customary 4" pipe marker was cemented in the top of the hole with 20 sacks of cement. All mud and cement plugs were pumped in through tubing. The above work was completed 9-29-45.
