DETAILS OF WORK

This well was drilled to a TD of 9324' with no oil, gas or water of commercial quantities encountered. Cored 5124-74', showed no oil. Ran GR-Sonic and Laterolog.

We propose to plug and abandon this well in the following manner: Spot 75 sz cement at TD, spot 100' cement from 1350-1450', spot 15 sz cement from 340-400', spot 5 sz cement at surface and fill intervals between plugs w/10#/gal mud; restore location to original condition and construct a 4" marker extending 4' above the surface with well name and location inscribed thereon.
