DETAILS OF WORK

This well was completed 10-30-54 at a TD of 13,034', to 12,690', Atoka formation. Well produced gas and dist. for a short time and then went to 100% water. Well is now watered out, incapable of commercial production.

It is our intention to deepen the well to 13,900', run an induction log, Microlog and Gamma Ray-Sonic log from 12,469-13,900', run a 3" flush-joint liner and cement 6/200 ex at 13,900' and perforate and acidize the Morrow Sand as determined from the logs.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
