Referring to our previous correspondence in regard to the casinghead gas you were developing in the Southwest Quarter: of Section 26, T225, R368, Les County, New Maxico, I have just been advised by our Field Superintendent that tests have been made on the two wells you now have completed on this tract and the HaS content is 138 grains per 100 cubic feet. This is too sour for us to take into our treated gas line which is the only line we have near this lease. Our Superintendent also reported that the two wells were only making approximately 40 MCF per day.

We understand that you plan by drill two more wells on this lease, and I would suggest that we wait much this lease is fully developed, at which time we will and will be in a better position to discu
