We have a letter from Mr. R. F. Montgomery, your Proration Manager at Hobbs, referring to our Ethel Shipley Owens Well No.2, Sec.26 T.22-S. R.36-E., Lea County, New Mexico. Mr. Montgomery states that we must obtain a connection for the sale of the casinghead gas, or secure a no-flare order from the Commission not later than September, 1957 for this well.

We, hereby, ask that an exception to the "No-Flare Order" be granted for our Ethel Shipley Owens Well No. 2. The lease on which this well is situated covers the southwest quarter of Sec.26 T.22-S. R.36-E., Lea County, New Mexico.

We have now completed Wells Nos. 1, 2, 3 & 4 on this lease.
