Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation respectfully requests that the Oil Conservation Commission grant an exception to No Flare Order R-553 insofar as it pertains to Gulf's A. L. Christmas "A" Well No. 3 and in support thereof states the following facts:

The A. L. Christmas "A" Well No. 3 is located 660' from the north line and 1,980' from the east line of Section 27, T-22-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico and was completed on July 10, 1956, in the South Eunice Pool. The well produced at the rate of 100 barrels of oil per day with a gas-oil ratio of 1,288 cubic feet per barrel. An oil allowable of 38 barrels per calendar day was assigned to the well for July.

The well is located approximately 3 miles from the nearest low pressure gathering system and there is an insufficient volume of gas in the immediate vicinity of the well to economically justify the cost of a gathering system extension to connect the gas at this time; however, we will endeavor to find a market for the gas as soon as possible.

In view of the foregoing and to keep the well on production and thereby protect correlative rights, it is requested that the Oil Conservation Commission issue an exception to its No Flare Order R-553 with respect to a volume of approximately 47 MCF per day of low pressure casinghead gas which will be vented from Gulf's A. L. Christmas "A" Well No. 3.

Gulf Oil Corporation respectfully requests that the Oil Conservation Commission grant an extension to No. 1290 (P.O. Box 1290) in order to be permitted to drill a well in the vicinity of the well in support thereof states the following facts:

The A. L. Christensen well No. 1 is located 660' from the north line and 1,980' from the east line of Section 47, T-24-N, R-36-E, Sec 47, T-24-N, R-36-E, New Mexico and was completed on July 10, 1956, in the Santa Fe area. The well produced at the rate of 100 barrels of oil per day with a gas-oil ratio of 1,200 cubic feet per barrel. In oil fields of 30 barrels per acre and up was assigned to the well for July.

The well is located approximately 3 miles from the nearest low pressure gathering system and there is an insufficient volume of gas in the immediate vicinity of the well to economically justify the cost of a gathering system extension to connect the gas at this time; however, we will endeavor to find a market for the gas as soon as possible.

In view of the foregoing and to keep the well on production and thereby protect conservative rights, it is requested that the Oil Conservation Commission issue an exception to the No. 1290 (P.O. Box 1290) with respect to a volume of approximately 17,000 barrels of low pressure oil which will be vented from the A. L. Christensen well No. 1.

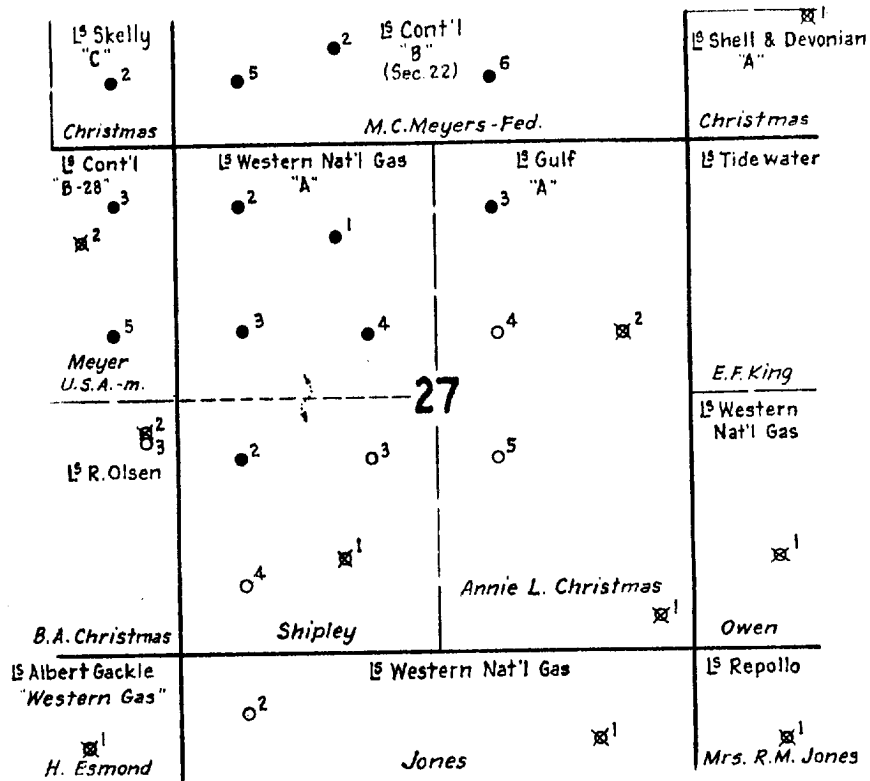

320-acres


