Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation respectfully requests that the Oil Conservation Commission grant an exception to No-Flare Order R-553 insofar as it pertains to Gulf's A. L. Christmas "A" Well No. 4 and in support thereof states the following facts:

The A. L. Christmas "A" Well No. 4 is located 1980' from the north line and 1980' from the east line of Section 27, T22S, R36E, Lea County, New Mexico, and was completed on August 7, 1956, in the South Eunice Pool. The well produced at the rate of 348 barrels of oil per day with a gas-oil ratio of 1291 cubic feet per barrel. An oil allowable of 39 barrels per calendar day was assigned to the well.

The well is located approximately 3 miles from the nearest low pressure gathering system and there is an insufficient volume of gas in the immediate vicinity of the well to economically justify the cost of a gathering system extension to connect the gas at this time; however, we will endeavor to find a market for the gas as soon as possible.

In view of the foregoing and to keep the well on production and thereby protect correlative rights, it is requested that the Oil Conservation Commission issue an exception to its No-Flare Order R-553 with respect to a volume of approximately 50 MCF per day of low pressure casinghead gas which will be vented from Gulf's A. L. Christmas "A" Well No. 4.

Gulf Oil Corporation respectfully requests that the Oil Conservation Commission grant an exception to its No-Flare Order R-553 insofar as it pertains to Gulf's A. I. Cristinas No. 4 and in support thereof state the following facts:

The A. I. Cristinas No. 4 Well No. 4 is located 1950' from the north line and 1940' from the east line of Section 27, T23N, R36E, Las Alamos County, New Mexico, and was completed on August 7, 1956, in the South Santa Fe Pool. The well produced at the rate of 325 barrels of oil per day with a gas-oil ratio of 1200 cubic feet per barrel. An oil allowance of 20 barrels per calendar day was assigned to the well.

The well is located approximately 2 miles from the nearest low pressure gathering system and there is no insubstantial volume of gas in the immediate vicinity of the well so economic disposal of gas in the gathering system extension to locally justify the cost of a gathering system extension to connect the well at this time; however, we will endeavor to find a market for the gas as soon as possible.

In view of the foregoing and to keep the well on production and thereby protect conservation interests, it is requested that the Oil Conservation Commission issue an exception to its No-Flare Order R-553 with respect to a volume of approximately 50 MCF per day of low pressure casinghead gas which will be vented from Gulf's A. I. Cristinas No. 4 Well No. 4.

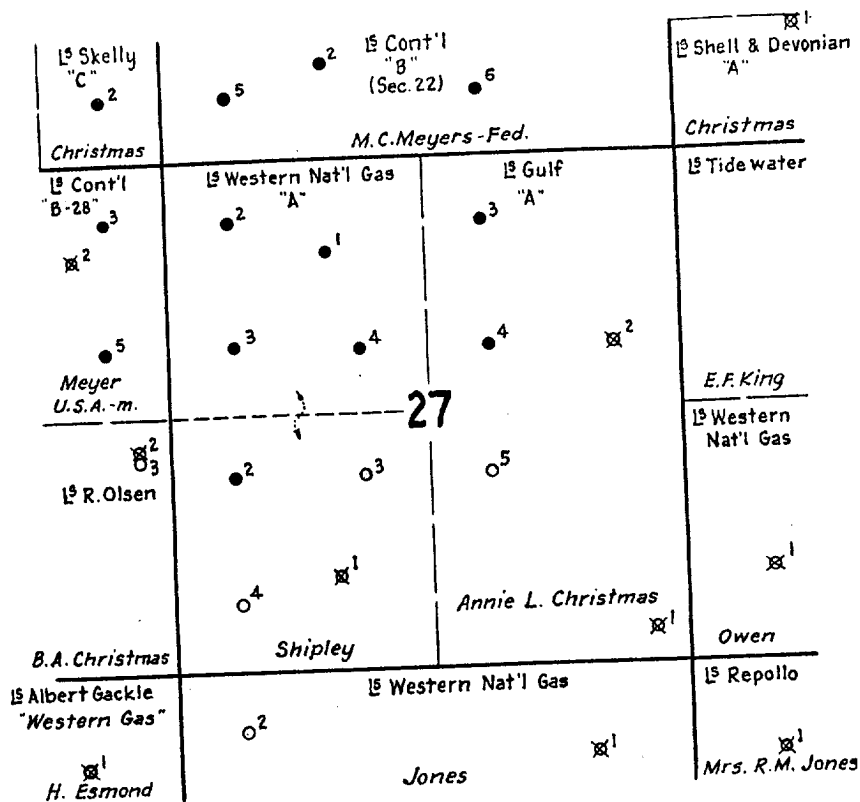
