Gentlemen:

We herewith make application in triplicate for a gas proration unit of 160 acres consisting of the southwest quarter of Section 27, Township 22S, Range 36E, Lea County, New Mexico. This unit is to be assigned to our Shipley #1 well in the Jalmat Pool, located 990' from the south line and 1650' from the west line of Section 27-22S-36E. We attach herewith three copies of the plat of this unit showing acreage involved, the location of the well, and the offset ownership.

We wish to make the following statements in compliance with Order No. R-520:

1. Our Shipley #1 well was completed on June 6, 1947 as a gas well in the Yates-Upper Seven Rivers and in conformance with the rules and regulations in effect at that time.
2. This well is completed within the vertical limits and horizontal limits of the Jalmat Pool.
3. The location falls within the limits prescribed for a 160 acre unit by Rule 5 (a), Order No. R-520.
4. The unit consists of continuous and contiguous acreage.
5. The unit lies wholly within a governmental section.
6. In my opinion, the unit is reasonably productive of gas.
7. The unit does not exceed 5280' along its length or width.

The herewith made application in triplicate for a gas prospect well in the northwest quarter of Section 21, Township 22S, Range 12E, 12th County, New Mexico. This well is to be located on the west line of 800' from the south line and 100' from the west line of 800' from the south line.
