Your proposed work is approved subject to compliance with the revisions of the "Oil and Gas Operating Regulations" revised May 25, 1942, copy of which will be furnished you on request, and subject to the following conditions:

1. Drilling operations so authorized are subject to the attached sheet (revised February 1956) for general conditions of approval.
2. Cement behind the 5 1/2" casing must extend to 200 feet above the top of the salt as determined by temperature survey.
