DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On February 4, 1936 well was plugged from 3922' to 3632' with 70 sacks cement, or from bottom to 10' up into 7" casing at approximately 3430' and heavy mud put in well. The 7" casing was shot off at 3398' and pulled. Hole was bridged and filled with mud, and cement plug placed in top of 9-5/8" casing with 4" pipe marker 4' high cemented in plug. Cellar was filled with earth. Final abandonment 4-7-36.
