FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK (FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

Subject well presently loads up with water and dies.

We propose to pull tbg, run retrievable BP & Pkr combination on tbg, set BP at 3400', Pkr at 3350' and test the 3360-90' interval. Reset BP at 3340', Pkr at 3250' and test interval 3268-3300'. Reset BP at 3225', Pkr at 3090' and test interval 3100-3226'. Pull tbg, BP & Pkr, run re-tainer, squeeze water productive zones; Run tbg to within one joint of bottom, land in head, swab off and return to production.

Subsequent report will be filed upon completion of this work.
