Gentlemen:

Cities Service Oil Company respectfully requests that you approve this appli-
cation for the designation and formation of a 320 acre non-standard gas
proration unit consisting of the E/2 of Section 30, Township 22 South, Range 36
East, Lea County, New Mexico, and that it be assigned to the Closson "B" No.
11.

In support of this application we wish to state the following:

1. The Closson "B" No. 11, located 1980' FNL and 660' FEL, Section 30, T-22-S, R-36-E, has been completed as a gas well from within the vertical limits of the Jalmat Gas Pool.
2. This non-standard gas proration unit consists of contiguous quarter/quarter sections within a single governmental section and the entire unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
3. All operators owning interests within 1500' of the Closson "B" No. 11 have been furnished copies of this application by registered mail.
4. A plat of the area indicating the proposed non-standard gas proration unit and effect ownership is attached.

An exception to Rule 5-A, Order R-520, permitting the assignment of a 320 acre non-standard gas proration unit to this well is requested.

1. The proposed unit No. 11, located 1950' NW and 200' E of Section 30, T-32-S, R-30-E, has been completed as a gas well from within the vertical limits of the latter gas pool.
2. This non-standard gas protection unit consists of wellbore gas production within a single governmental quarter/quarter section and the entire unit may reasonably be expected to be productive of gas.
3. All operations during the period within 1960' of the proposed unit No. 11 have been furnished copies of this application to the registered well.
