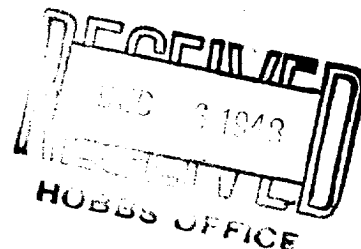

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

In attempt to increase oil production on subject well, the following work was performed:

Original total depth of well was 3625'. Pulled tubing, set retainer at 3600' with 10 sacks cement, perforated 5-1/2" casing 3562-3568' with 36 shots, 3574-3580' with 36 shots and 3584-3587' with 18 shots. After recovering oil load, tested no oil, gas or water on 4 hour test. Acidized with 500 gallons.

Recompleted for initial potential of 880 barrels oil, no water, in 24 hours, based on 3 hour test of 110 barrels oil, no water, flowing through 3/4" choke on 2" tubing with 600 MCF gas, GOR 682, C.P. 400#, T.P. 75#. Production before workover was ~~With 600 MCF gas~~ With 600 MCF gas 837 MCF gas per day.
