

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After a 24 hour shut-in period the shut-in tubing pressure was 513.5 psia as measured by a dead weight pressure gage. The volume of gas was measured with a D.F. recorder on the El Paso Natural Gas Company's meter run. The test was conducted and calculated in accordance with the revised back pressure test manual for natural gas wells dated 7-21-50, as prescribed by the Railroad Commission of Texas. The resulting ABSOLUTE OPEN FLOW WAS 6,500 MCF PER 24 HOURS with a G of 45°.
