DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After a 24 hour shut-in period the tubing pressure was 1034 psig. Based on a back pressure test taken on 3-29-50, which indicated an absolute open flow of 5,750 MCF/24 hours with a shut-in casing pressure of 1042 psig and a 41.5° slope back pressure curve, the ABSOLUTE OPEN FLOW IS 5670 MCF/24 HRS.
