DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After drilling to a depth of 1,395' from the derrick floor, 9 5/8" O. D. 36#, S-40 new casing was cemented at 1384.80' with 700 sacks El Toro regular cement which circulated to the surface. After waiting 24 hours for the cement to harden, the casing was tested with 1000# for 30 minutes. There was no drop in the pressure.
