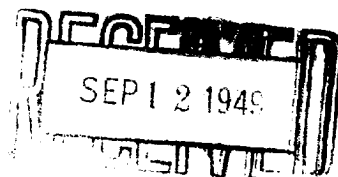

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was gravel packed back from total depth of 3395' to 3322'. The hole was loaded with 225 quarts of nitroglycerin in 3" containers with 2 American Glycerin time bombs. The shot was tamped with 40 gallons of gravel. A 7 sack Calseal plug was placed on top of the gravel. The plug back depth was 3095. The shot went off at 10:34 AM on September 7, 1949. We are now cleaning out the well.
