Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

Drilled to 3800' at 3 AM 5-12-58. Ran 115 joints of 4 1/2" OD 9.5# casing, 3787', set at 3800'. Cemented with 1400 sacks of Lone Star cement as follows: 1000 sacks of 50-50 Diamix with 1/4# of Flocele per sack and 3% gel followed with 400 sacks of Incor neat. Plug down with fresh water @ 2:15 AM 5-13-58. Cement circulated. WOC 24 hours. Tested casing with 1000# for 30 minutes OK. Drilled out cement from 3765' to 3775'.
