Dear Sir:

Please refer to our letter from Mr. R. F. Montgomery, stating that it will be necessary for us to apply for a no-flare order from the Commission not later than 1-17-58, in the event a gas connection has not been made to our State McDonald A/C 1 "B" Well No. 4 by that date.

We hereby ask that an exception to the "No-Flare" order be granted for this well. The lease on which this well is situated covers the east half of Sec. 26 and the northeast quarter of Sec. 35, T22S R36E, Lea County, New Mexico.

Wells Nos. 1, 2, and 3 have also been completed on this lease.

We have a contract with Phillips Petroleum Company, whereby they will purchase the casinghead gas from these wells as soon as they have the necessary gathering line installed and connected.

Please refer to our letter of December 30, 1957, to which we attached a copy of a letter we received from Phillips stating the project was delayed another 120 days from that date.

The volume of gas to be flared from State McDonald A/C 1 "B" Well No. 4 is approximately 24 MCF per day. The gas-oil ratio of this well is 552:1.
