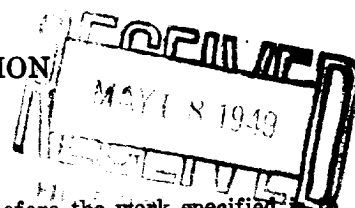

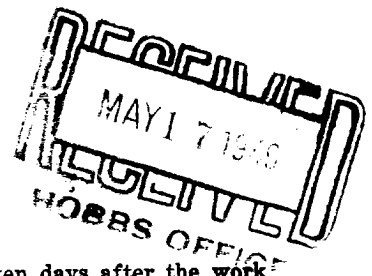

On 5-16-49 3975' of 7" pipe was run and cemented with 300 sacks. The calculated amount of cement necessary to protect the salt section was 350 sacks. An additional 150 sacks was run as a precautionary measure. The plug was pumped down at 7:00 P. M. on 5-16-49 and the casing was tested with 1000#. There was no pressure drop and everything was O. K.

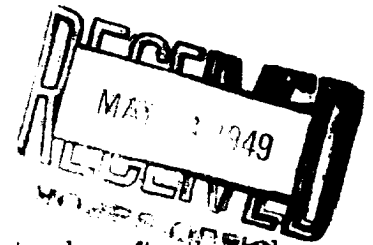
