Meridian requests administrative approval to simultaneously dedicate a 160-acre gas proration unit, being the SE/4 of Sec. 1, T23S, R36E, Lea County, New Mexico, to the Emery King SE Wells No.'s 1 & 3.


Well No. 1 is presently in the Jalmat-Tansill-Yates-7 Rivers Pool and was previously assigned a non-standard 160-acre gas proration unit.

Well No. 3 is presently temporarily abandoned in the Langlie Mattix SR-QN-GB as an oil well. Proposed plans are to recomplete Well No. 3 to the Jalmat-Tansill-Yates-7 Rivers gas pool and simultaneously dedicate the non-standard 160-acre gas proration unit assigned to Well No. 1.

Enclosed is a list of all offset operators and their addresses. All offsets were notified by certified mail return receipt on 8/15/91. A copy of a land plat is also enclosed showing offsetting leases.
