DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Tested casing and top plug for 30 minutes with 1000# pressure. Drilled top plug and found plug at 1420'. Tested casing and bottom plug w/ 1000# pressure applied for 30 minutes. Drilled bottom plug, 2964' to 3000'. Tested 5 1/2" casing and cement with 1000# pressure applied for 30 minutes. All tests were OK, and after approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were being made to complete the well.

Top of cement back of 5-1/2" casing at 1025' per temperature survey.
