Gentlemen:

Reference is made to the No Flare Orders No. 420 and 422 whereby the Oil Conservation Commission granted approval to flare gas from our J. F. Janda (NCT-I) Wells No. 3 and 4, respectively, located in the N/2 of Section 2, T-23-S, R-36-E, Langlie-Mattix Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

A progress report is required by NFO-420 prior to February 1, 1959, and prior to February 27, 1959, by NFO-422, showing the progress we have made in attempting to obtain a gas connection for these wells.

We were advised by Warren Petroleum Corporation on December 17, 1958, that they will purchase this gas and are in the process of preparing an AFE to expand their plant and gathering facilities to process this gas in their Eunice Plant. The estimated date of completion and connection for the wells located on our J. F. Janda (NCT-I) Lease is not known at this time; however, when we are informed of this we will advise you.

In view of the above, we respectfully request that an extension be granted for No Flare Orders No. 420 and No. 422. In the event that additional information is needed, please advise.
