Gulf Oil Corporation respectfully requests that the Oil Conservation Commission grant an exception to No-Flare Order R-553 insofar as it pertains to Gulf's J. F. Janda "I" Lease, Well No. 3 and in support thereof furnishes the following facts:

The J. F. Janda "I" Lease, Well No. 3 is located 660 feet from the north and west lines of Section 2, T-23-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico. This well was completed on June 19, 1958, as an oil well in the Langlie-Mattix Pool. The well tested 55 barrels of oil in twenty-four hours with a gas volume of 142 MCF. The estimated volume of casinghead gas to be produced is 85 MCF per day based on an allowable of 33 barrels and a gas-oil ratio of 2,585 cubic feet per barrel.

There is no low pressure gas gathering system located on this lease since J. F. Janda "I" Well Nos. 1 and 2 produce high pressure Jalmat Gas. However, we are in the process of obtaining a market for the low pressure gas. The nearest low pressure gas gathering system, located a distance of approximately three-fourths of a mile, is owned by Phillips Petroleum Company.

In view of the foregoing information and in order to keep this well on production and thereby protect correlative rights, it is requested
