Ran 3007' of 7" 20# Seamless J-55 Casing and set at 3017'. Cemented with 570 sacks of 3%, 81 sacks of Signalite and 200 sacks of Neat. Circulated 100 sacks. Tested pipe and casing seat on October 27, 1952, with 950 psi for 30 minutes before and after the drilling of the cement. Both held O.K.
