Dear Sir:

On February 10, 1956, Order NSP-242 approved the formation of a 330-acre non-standard gas proration unit for your Sinclair-State Well No. 4, located SE/4 NE/4 of Section 3, Township 23 South, Range 36 East, Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. The formation of this unit was actually the combination of two units, each containing approximately 160 acres, the acreage comprising the entire N/2 of the Section.

At the end of December, 1955, the proration unit assigned your Well No. 3, which comprised the NW/4 of Section 3, had accrued a net under-
age of 260,508. Since the well was re-worked and recompleted as an oil well and given an oil allowable in January, the gas allowable for that month was cancelled. Since your No. 4 well, which is now the well to which all of the acreage in the proration unit is dedicated, had a January net allowable of 36,747, the net allowable for this well is being increased in the amount of 260,508, making its revised January net allowable 297,255. The total under-
age chargeable against this well and proration unit on December 31 (the end of a 6-month proration period) is 278,304. This amount of gas must be made up during the present proration period in addition to the normal allowable assigned the well and any amount not made up will be subject to cancellation at the end of this proration period, June 30, 1956.
