This is to advise that effective July 1, 1962 your J. F. Janda NCT-J Well No. 1 located in Unit I of Section 4, T-23-S, R-36-E will be reclassified as a gas well in the Jalmat Gas Pool due to the recently submitted gas-oil ratio test, which shows the well to be producing with a ratio in excess of 100,000:1.
