Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation respectfully requests that the Oil Conservation Commission grant an exception to No-Flare Order R-553 and authorize the production of oil and venting or flaring the casinghead gas from Gulf's J. F. Janda "J" No. 2, Langlie-Mattix Pool (Undesignated) oil well, located in the SE/4 of Section 4, T-22-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

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In support of this application the following facts are furnished:

The J. F. Janda "J" Well No. 2, which is located 660 feet from the South and East lines of Section 4, T-23-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico, was completed on April 14, 1957. The well is currently assigned an allowable of 37 barrels per day and the gas-oil ratio is approximately 1,170 cubic feet per barrel. The estimated gas production on the basis of 37 barrels per day allowable is 43 MCF per day.

El Paso Natural Gas Company has an intermediate pressure gas gathering system on this lease taking gas produced from J. F. Janda "J" No. 1 oil well in the Jalmat Pool; however, the gathering system operated up to 300# pressure and the J. F. Janda "J" No. 2 can not be produced at a pressure high enough to enable delivery of gas into this system. There are no low pressure gas gathering systems in the vicinity of this well.
