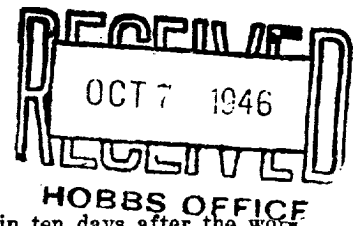

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Set 10" casing @ 252' cemented w/250 sacks August 30, 1946. Drilled plug and tested pipe w/600# pump pressure before and after drilling plug September 1, 1946.

Set 7-5/8" 24# pipe @ 2978' cemented w/550 sacks September 11, 1946. Drilled plug and tested pipe before and after drilling w/1200# pump pressure September 14, 1946.

Set 5-1/2" 14# pipe @ 3825' cemented w/200 sacks September 25, 1946. Drilled out cement, washed hole, and tested pipe w/1000# pump pressure September 27, 1946.
