Gentlemen:

Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 5 (b) of Order No. R=520 for a non-standard gas proration unit for its Farney A-5 No. 3, well located 660" FN and E lines of Section 5, T-23S., R-36E., Lea County, New Mexico in the Jalmat gas pool. This well was recently reclassified as a gas well.

The unit is proposed to consist of the Northeast (warter of Section 5, T-235, R-36E.

In support of this request we should like to point out that the proposed unit conforms with the requirements of said Rule 5 (b) in all respects as follows:

- 1. Said unit consists of contiguous guarter-quarter sections (and/or lots).
- 2. Said unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- 3. The entire proposed unit may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas.
- The length or width of said unit does not exceed 4. 5,280'.
- 5. Copies of this application have been furnished by registered mail to all offset operators and all operators within 1,500 feet of said well.

A plat is attached hereto showing to the best of our knowledge or belief the proposed unit, the location of the well and the offset ownership.

In view of the facts set out herein it is respectfully requested that the Commission issue an order approving the non-scanderd gas proration unit for Continental ULL Company's Farmey A-3 No. 19 0001 as described above.

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
