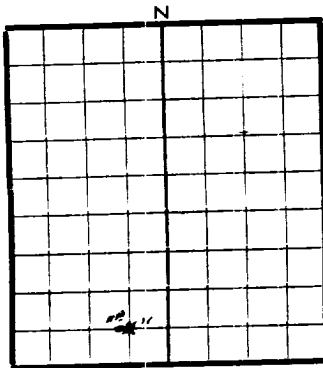

 4 sacks Cotton Seed Hulls
 91 sacks Grevia Stop
 5,200 pounds Jellake
 15 tons Aquagel
 33 tons Baroid
 557 tons Mud
 10,476 sacks cement, 4% Aquagel
