## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We propose to complete this well as a gas well -

As previously reported this well, while drilling for oil in the usual horizon, lost circulation at 3592' where blew out on December 21, 1943. In bringing this gas under control we used the following materials:

2 bails fibrex  
4 sacks cotton seed hulls  
91 sacks crevis stop  
5,200 pounds Jelflake  
15 tons aquagel  
33 tons baroid  
557 tons mud  
10,476 sacks cement (4% aquagel)

The drill pipe was cemented in the hole and the gas completely shut off.

We are now seeking your approval to gun-perforate the drill pipe in this hole from 3110-40, 3160-3220, 3230-70, to make a gas well, which will then be produced through drill pipe cemented in hole.
