FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well is producing 10 bbls oil and 2600 bbls water daily from perforated intervals at 3482-90 and 3512-20, by gas lift. It is proposed to set a retainer at approximately 3505 and squeeze off the lower perforations with cement and retest. Present plugged back depth is 3540'. Due to the large volume of water, it has become uneconomical to produce the well.
