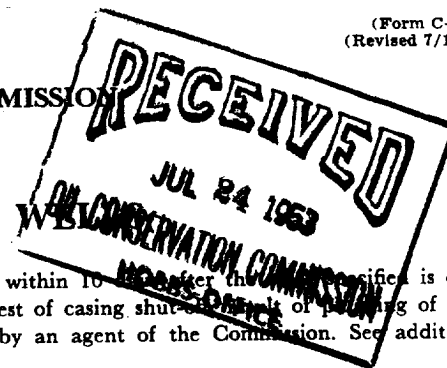

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well spudded July 14, 1953. It is proposed to drill to a depth of approximately 3200'.

Ran 317' of 9-5/8" 32# Seamless H-40 casing and set at 329'. Cemented with 300 sacks of Neat and circulated 60 sacks. Pipe and casing seat were tested on July 17, 1953, for 30 minutes with 800 psi before and after the drilling out of the cement and both held OK.
