Ran 2950' of 7" 20# Seamless J-55 casing and set at 2959'. Cemented with 760 sacks 3% Gel, 190 sacks of Signalite and 200 sacks of Neat. Circulated 100 sacks. Pipe and casing seat were tested with 1200 psi for 30 minutes before and after the drilling out of the cement and both held O.K.
