Ran 331' of 9 5/8" 32# Seamless J-55 casing and set at 342'. Cemented with 300 sacks of Neat and circulated 40 sacks. Pipe and casing seat tested with 1200 psi for 30 minutes on March 2, 1953, before and after the drilling out of the cement. Both held O.K.
